



Camp Student Guidelines

Please go through this page with your student. Our leaders have been encouraged to enforce these rules and dress code in a loving but firm way, and will ask students to change if they are dressed unsuitably for an activity. Students who consistently break rules, behave inappropriately, or engage in pranks will be sent home at their parents expense.

The Understood

Never hurt anyone physically, emotionally or spiritually.

NO PRANKS!

ALL camp activities are mandatory for everyone. Students may not skip or hang out whenever they choose.

Never be alone with a member of the opposite sex.

Respect **ALL** authority figures. This includes leaders, youth staff, and camp staff.

Never enter a room belonging to the opposite sex.

Never leave your room after lights out.

Students and leaders are financially responsible for any room damages. Please be cautious!

Use and/or possession of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, or weapons of any kind is grounds for immediate dismissal from camp.

Dress Code

Halter tops, tank tops, and spaghetti straps (girls) may NOT be worn.

Tight fitting/revealing clothing and shirts that expose the midriff or undergarments may NOT be worn.

No short shorts (fingertip length)

Clothing with suggestive slogans/logos or inappropriate language may NOT be worn.

No two-piece bathing suites (girls) or Speedo style swimsuits (guys).

Any other inappropriate items (staff and leaders have the authority on this).
